

## Visitors Parking Guidelines for Sunset Cove

February, 2020

### This is how the Visitors Parking Guidelines work in Sunset Cove:

- 1.) If you are having a visitor for a few hours, they may park on the street (but not overnight) where there are no yellow curbs or signs prohibiting parking.
- 2.) If you are having a visitor for a longer period of time and/or overnight, they may park in a Visitor Parking space (subject to availability). They can fill out the Visitor Form ahead of time **OR** it can be filled out if Parking Enforcement places a copy of the form (not a sticker) on their vehicle. This occurs on the day/night that their vehicle is identified by Parking Enforcement as being parked in a Visitor Parking Space. At this time, they have (5) days to turn the form in to AMI. They will not be ticketed during this (5) day period. Upon returning the completed Visitors Form, they will be added to the Visitors Parking List. They will then be in compliance with the Visitors Parking guidelines.
- 3.) If a visitor's vehicle is on the Visitors Parking List, they may park their vehicle in a Visitors Parking Space at **any** time (subject to availability).

As stated in the February, 2020 Sunset Cove Homeowners Association Community Newsletter, the (3) step enforcement guidelines apply to **both** Resident Parking and Visitor Parking. **NO** vehicle in either area will be towed on their **1<sup>st</sup>** violation. Only vehicles on the street between 12am and 5am will be towed without warning.
